She worked for Rotary International headquarters in Evanston where she was regional events coordinator and manager of training. She returned to Muncie in 2005 and joined the CFMDC in 2006 as an officer. Her last visit to our club was as an official visit by Rotary Foundation. The CFMDC was founded in 1985 from a vision of Ed Ball with help from co founders Steve Anderson and Tom Kinghorn. **1986 Muncie Children's Museum** received their 1st grant and to-date MCM has received 112 grants totaling \$1.4 mil.; other grant recipients that year were **United Way** - 95 grants now totaling \$1.2mil.; **Muncie Civic Theater**- 259 grants now totaling \$107,000. **1987 M.O.Ms** received its 1st grant and it has now received 38 grants totaling \$250,000. **1989 Minnetrista** received its 1st grant and it has now received 89 grants totaling \$122,000. **1990 Habitat** received its 1st grant and it has now received 42 grants totaling \$25,000. **1994 Cardinal Greenway** received its 1st grant and it has now received 56 grants totaling \$600,000. **1996 Eaton Public Library** received its 1st grant and it has now received 12 grants totaling \$50,000. **1997 Daleville Library** received its 1st grant and it has now received 59 grants totaling \$309,000. **1999 Cornerstone Center for the Arts** received its 1st grant and it has now received 81 grants totaling \$700,000. **2002 ARF- Animal rescue Fund** received its 1st grant and it has now received 18 grants totaling \$27,000. **2005 Beyond I Can ?** received its 1st grant and it has now received 3 grants totaling \$36,000. **2006 Back To School Teacher's Store** received its 1st grant and it has now received 4 grants totaling \$23,000. **In 2010 CFMDC will celebrate its 25th Anniversary** to celebrate almost \$38mil assets and grant awards totaling \$30mil.
